The company, however, has been aggressive in defending against these types of lawsuits in the 1980s and 90s, and more recently in response to the efforts in Mississippi, Texas and several other states to turn silica litigation into a “mass tort”. Mr. Ulizio and U.S. Silica efforts were highlighted by the Wall Street Journal in a full page article last year.
