

Electrical Safety - Good Practices

LOTOTO-Lock out, tag out, try out. "Try out" is an equally important step. Helps to eliminate a hazard if something was mislabeled or wired incorrectly.



Always use GFCI receptacles.



Left Hand Rule - Never stand in front of a disconnect when turning it on. Most disconnect handles are on the right side of a cabinet. Stand to the right of the disconnect and use your left hand to turn it on. This way you will not be in front of the cabinet if something does go wrong.

Non-contact voltage testers, or volt ticks, may not work on shielded cables.



Always Test Your Meter...If not "Energized is probably energized, however don't believe that not energized is not energized. Bad Batteries, bad test leads, and old meters, could all be things that misguide you.

Utilize Overhead Markers.
